Page 3 Who are the Attorneys for the Plan

The law firm of *Willig, Williams & Davidson, 1845 Walnut Street, 24<sup>th</sup> Floor, Philadelphia, PA 19103* has been selected to provide legal services for the plan.

How to Use the Plan

1. Call the *Law Firm intake desk at 215-656-3600* to make an appointment with a Plan Attorney or you can contact the Legal Services Fund Coordinator (see #3 below). After your eligibility for benefits is confirmed, an appointment will be arranged for you. The appointment will be scheduled at the Law Firm.

Page 10 **9. Criminal Coverage.**

*The Plan will provide coverage for summary, misdemeanor and felony offenses one time per year for the Member only. Coverage will also include an appearance in traffic court for offenses that could result in the loss of the member's driver's license, but only if the new Citation itself carries a license suspension as a penalty.*

Page 16 **Member**

Delete words - **retiring on or after January 1, 1999 in copy below** (Already deleted in PHA booklet)

A person employed by a Contributing Employer who is eligible for the benefits provided by this Plan. The term Member also applies to employees of AFSCME, District Council 47 and its related entities on whose behalf contributions are submitted to the Fund. Member also includes retirees, **retiring on or after January 1, 1999** who are within 18 months of their retirement with the City of Philadelphia.
